Now, in the light of the above, we would like to bring to your kind attention that absence of gradation list of the unified service with effect from 01.03.2001, the benefits awarded by the Hon'ble CM may become meaningless and infructuous. We are further afraid that:

- As already the earlier gradation list published prior to 2001 is exhausted, a problem may be created in awarding promotion to Special Secretary which is already vacant and going to be vacant till the gradation list is published despite the fact that the total posts has been increased from 13 to 22. This would defeat the good intention of the Hon'ble CM
- The time period granted by Hon'ble SAT for publication of gradation list has elapsed long before and court cases including contempt of court may invite complications.
- Unless the gradation list is published in conformity with the existing seniority rules, a major complication may be invited in the near future during implementation of the service benefits as awarded by the Hon'ble CM.
- Last but not the least, non publication of gradation list might lead to difficulty in proper cadre management of WBA&AS.

We, therefore, earnestly urge to your goodself to publish the gradation list immediately without fail in accordance with the G.O. no. 9099- F dated 23/09/2009 maintaining the inter – se – seniority as on 1st March 2001 taking the date of joining into the service as the only criterion to give a winning pace to the milestone plan of improvement of service cadres by the Hon'ble CM , Govt . of West Bengal .
